(a) LOCATION OF TRAIN DISPATCHERS

In reference to paragraph (d), Consolidated Rail Corporation General Order No. 710, effective April 1, 1976, transferring portions of the Columbus Division to the Toledo Division. Train Dispatchers remain in charge as indicated:

1. That portion of the Columbus Division, Southern Region, designated as the Eastern Branch between Luckey MP 15.8 and Division Post (Toledo Division) (MP 8.5), transferred to the Toledo Division, Western Region, and Train Dispatcher at Columbus, Ohio, remains in charge.
2. Those portions of the Columbus Division, Southern Region, designated as the Sandusky Secondary Track between MP 16.4 and MP 17.0 at Clyde, Ohio, and between MP. 31.2 and MP 36.2 at Tiffin, Ohio, transferred to the Toledo Division, Western Region, and Train Dispatcher at Columbus, Ohio, remains in charge.

All Timetable Special Instructions remain in effect until transposed to Western Region Timetable No. 6. Special Instructions 1201-A2, page 197, applied and train orders will be issued over signature of the Superintendent of the Division of the Train Dispatcher in charge.
