SUBJECT: Finance Report

Accomplishments and Highlights of the Finance Section from November 10, 2005 to January 12, 2006:

1. Financial Statements prepared for January 3, 2006.
2. ORDC received \$67,999.75 and \$87,857.13 in November and December respectively.
3. ORDC had non-payroll expenditures of \$44,355.07 for November and December.
4. ORDC staff has completed the following loan closings: Portage County Solid Waste Management District - \$80,000 Cleveland Commercial Railroad - \$20,000 Portage County (Smurfit Stone) - \$20,000
5. City of Marion and Marion CAN DO! have released the ORDC from its \$600,000 loan commitment for the Dual Rail Park Connector for Dofasco project. A change in the Dofasco business plan has reduced the need of a connection to CSX for this particular plant.
6. I attended a one-day seminar on Rail Financing Seminar sponsored by AASHTO which discussed the implications and opportunities of financing rail projects under SAFETEA-LU. The seminar was extremely informative and I hope to bring the commission projects based on this new knowledge in the coming year.
7. ORDC staff met with ODOT officials regarding ODOT's rail bottleneck study to review the proposal and offer input.
8. ORDC staff continues to meet with representatives of CSX and central Ohio agencies concerning the proposed TRAC application for the development of an intermodal yard in the central Ohio area.
