WESTERN BRANCH
SCIOTO INTERLOCKING STATION

Scioto South East Quadrant Connection Track connecting Western Branch No. 2 Track with Main Line - Columbus to Indianapolis No. 1 Track, in service.

Facing interlocked switch for northward movement in Western Branch No. 2 Track located 529 feet south of Scioto Diamond leading to New South East Quadrant Connection Track, in service.

Dwarf Signal governing southward movement from New South East Quadrant Connection Track located 230 feet north of northward home signal at Scioto Interlocking leading to No. 2 Track Western Branch, in service.

Trailing hand-operated switch not equipped with electric lock for eastward movement in Main Line - Columbus to Indianapolis No. 1 Track located 629 feet east of Scioto Diamond leading from New South East Quadrant Connection Track, in service.

Trains must not enter or leave New South East Quadrant Connection Track at hand-operated switch in No. 1 Track 629 feet east of Scioto Diamond without authority of Operator and Connection Track must not be blocked with stored cars.
