Paragraph (a) of Bulletin Order 6-58 and Paragraph (c) of Bulletin Order 6-562 referring to switching Compressed Gases, annulled.

- (b) ENTIRE DIVISION  
SWITCHING FLAMMABLE  
COMPRESSED GASES

In compliance with F.R.A. Emergency Order No. 5 D.O.T. specification Tank Cars 112-A and 114-A that are not equipped with head shields transporting flammable compressed gas (Dangerous) shall not be cut off in motion. No car moving under its own momentum shall be allowed to strike any D.O.T. 112-A or 114-A Tank Car containing flammable compressed gas placarded Dangerous that is not equipped with head shields nor shall any such car be coupled into with more force than is necessary to complete the coupling.

Shipping papers required by Section 174.510 General Notice 225-F, Page 57, for Loaded Tank Cars containing flammable compressed gas placarded Dangerous must indicate the "D.O.T. Specification Number of the Tank Car".

Employees assigned to handle such cars must be informed as to the requirements of F.R.A. Emergency Order No. 5.
